
Major suggestions by stakeholders

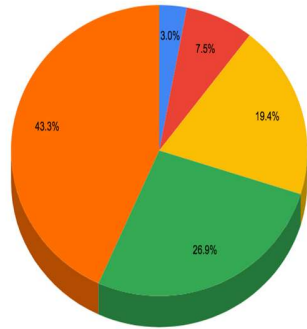
