A SUCCESSFUL CORPORATE CONCLAVE

The Centre for Placement and Career Guidance celebrates the success of its first edition of The Corporate Conclave: Corporate Conclave 2023 "The Epiphany Effect". The preparations for the event was in full swing over the month of September, with over 30 faculty members, 70 student volunteers and numerous non-teaching staff working together to organize and make the event a grand and resounding success.

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The vision of Corporate Conclave was to strengthen collaborations between the Industry and Academia, and foster mutually beneficial relationships with each other. With this in mind, the mega-event enabled insightful panel discussions and inclusive breakout sessions between corporates and faculty members.

The event was attended by leaders from various professional domains. The inaugural address was delivered by Dr. Fr. Jose CC, and The keynote address was delivered by Dr. C Jayakumar, the Vice President and Head CHRO of Larsen & Toubro. Further, the event saw two insightful panel discussions on Industry Academia Collaborations, and Industry 5.0. The Centre designed and released a dedicated newsletter for Corporate Conclave 2023, which has been mailed to the student and teaching community of the University. The colleges that were covered included London School of Economics, University of London, Education Institutes in Germany and The USA. Personal assistance was provided to students during a Q&A session, ensuring doubts were addressed.

UG PLACEMENT REPORT SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER

As the semester reaches its end, CHRIST (Deemed to be University) has so-far experienced a wave of enthusiastic activity in the undergraduate placement domain. Several renowned companies have walked through our gates, aiming to pick Christites from a diverse array of academic departments. This article offers a snapshot of the top eleven companies that have, so far, entrusted our students with promising roles for their future.

Over the months of September and October, several companies hired talent from the Campus. They were: Verity, Tresvista, ICICI Bank, RSM US LLP, KMPG KGS, Merilytics, EY India, Deutsche Bank, Wissen Technology.

In the month of September, Verity hired 5 students for the role of Analyst. Tresvista hired a record 124 students for the role of Analyst. The students who were hired came from courses like BCom Honours, BCom Mornings, BA HEP, BBA F&A, BBA Honours and Bsc. CMS. Further, Tresvista also hired a set of students for the role of CFO Analyst.

After Tresvista, the campus saw a successful placement drive by ICICI Bank, who hired 18 students for the role of Graduate Trainee. The CTC offered was 600000 per annum. This was followed by the Placement drive from RSM US LLP, who hired students for the role of Audit Associate. The process happened on September 29, and a total of 13 students were hired for the role. Even KPMG KGS hired for the role of Audit Associate in October. Here too, a total of 13 students were hired for the role, a total of 13 students were hired for the role.

Another leading placement drive was conducted by Deutsche Bank, hiring for the role of Operations Associate. After the placement process that happened in October, 25 students were selected and offer letters were given.

SAP Labs, Merilytics, Goldman Sachs, EY India were among the other companies that hired from campus in the last two months. The roles included CFO Analyst, Trainee Associate, HR Associate and others. In total, more than 200 students were placed in the last two months.

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PG PLACEMENT REPORT SEPTEMBER & OCTOBER

PG recruitments in the months of September and October unfolded with a variety of placement drives, offering unique opportunities for aspiring professionals. Our journey began with the prestigious KPIT, where the University placement cell streamlined the application process. Candidates submitted resumes and completed a certification course in German, leading to shortlisting by KPIT's HR team.

The initial hurdle was an online assessment on Superset, covering general aptitude, excel proficiency, HR domain knowledge, and communication skills. Successful candidates moved on to a critical 20-minute interview, evaluating interpersonal skills, internship experiences, and knowledge-based situational questions. The second round delved into technical aspects, focusing on excel skills, HR-related queries, and a brief overview of the candidate's course.

The confirmation mail for the final internship round arrived a week later, requesting details from the previous internship and mentors. The anticipation for the offer letter was palpable, marking the culmination of a thorough and fair assessment by KPIT.

Simultaneously, Gartner conducted a comprehensive recruitment process at Christ University. The journey began with a Pre-Placement Talk on August 31, held virtually, providing an overview of Gartner's history, mission, values, job opportunities, company culture, and application process.

The Aptitude Test, held on the same day, evaluated candidates' problem-solving, logical reasoning, and quantitative abilities. A Skill Test followed, testing writing skills, domain knowledge, and critical thinking. The process culminated in Personal Interviews on September 13, assessing candidates' behavioral, technical, and domain-related competencies.

Drishti Strategic Research Pvt. Ltd embarked on a talent acquisition journey on campus, aiming to identify Assistant Research Managers. The placement drive, starting on September 25, unfolded with a Pre Placement Talk providing valuable insights into the role, company culture, and expectations.

An Online Assessment on October 4 evaluated candidates' academic and practical aptitude, setting the stage for an Elevator Pitch submission to showcase strategic thinking and creativity. The subsequent Interview Rounds aimed to comprehensively evaluate candidates, with the Result Announcement on October 17 marking the end of the drive.

Deloitte USI Tax Consultant, in a parallel endeavor, also conducted a placement drive at CHRIST. The comprehensive process included a Pre-Placement Talk, Versant and Business Proficiency Test, and Interviews on September 25. The evaluation covered verbal, accountancy, problem-solving, and excel proficiency. The result announcement on the same day marked the culmination of a day filled with evaluations, interactions, and opportunities.

Deloitte India's placement drive added another dimension to the recruitment landscape on campus. Starting on September 26, the drive targeted students from Master's in Economics and M Com. The event included a Pre-Placement Talk, Versant and Business Proficiency Test, and Interviews on October 18. The process showcased Deloitte India's commitment to identifying talent aligning with their requirements.

Overall, the placement drives showcased a spectrum of opportunities, from the technical assessments of KPIT to the strategic evaluations of Drishti Strategic Research, the global perspectives of Gartner, and the comprehensive processes at Deloitte USI Tax Consultant and Deloitte India. Each drive demanded unique skills and preparation, highlighting the rigorous yet rewarding nature of recruitment processes.
