

**Workshop II on
Designing a Constructively Aligned Curriculum for Faculty Coordinators and
Curriculum Development Cell members**

on October 3 and 4, 2019

Venue: Campus View and Sky View, Central Block, Main Campus

Faculty is one of the core strengths of any institute of higher education. At CHRIST (Deemed to be University) there is constant emphasis on strengthening the faculty through several in-service training programs as the faculty play a significant role in translating the vision and mission of the university into achievable goals. The draft of the National Education Policy, along with the directives from the University Grants Commission, is indicative of the shift towards an outcome based curriculum. It is in this context that the workshop on designing a constructively aligned curriculum is being organized for Department coordinators and CDC members.

This one day workshop aims to orient faculty coordinators and curriculum development members to the concept of constructive alignment. The sessions would be designed to help faculty understand the curriculum guidelines of the university, review programme and course outcomes, map these with pedagogy and assessment. The participants will then be expected to share their learning with the members of their departments.

The objectives of the workshop are to:

- Provide a platform for dialogue on designing a constructively aligned curriculum
- Familiarize participants with outcome based language
- Enable them to review and design programme outcomes, programme specific outcomes, and course outcomes in alignment with the graduate outcomes of the university
- Equip them with resources to train faculty in their respective departments

At the end of the workshop participants should be able to:

- Use outcome based language to review and develop programme outcomes, course outcomes and learning outcomes and align them to the graduate attributes
- Conceptualize ways to transfer these skills to their respective departments and present a plan for the same
- Identify and address gaps in the existing syllabus of their departments

This workshop will be conducted with support from the Bamboo Grant from the United Board of Christian Higher Education in Asia.
