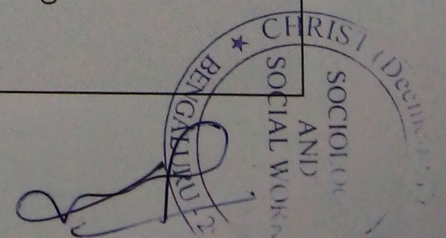

Sessions by CAPS during the Odd Semester 2016 for MA Applied Sociology

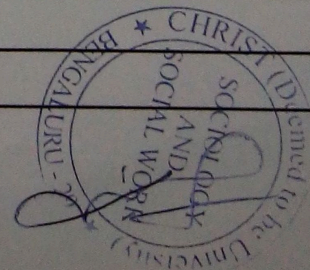
