
Q 1: Have you gained knowledge from this training?

In this training 17 faculty members took part and All the participants responded that they gained the knowledge


Q 2: Rate your overall knowledge level about the topics covered after attending the training



Most of the participants responded that they gained satisfactory knowledge from the training




Q 3: How did you find the content of this training
