A seminar on "Professional Skill Development" was held on 10th NOV 2018. The guest lecture began with the welcome address of the guests and the session was handed over to the guests. The first speaker began critical thinking which includes six categories: Knowledge, Comprehension, Application, Analysis, Synthesis, and Evaluation.
